

Steering Column options

Looking for an alternative to the Corolla steering column? Try a Nissan Skyline or Pintara column. They are a far superior and more substantial column than the Corolla. No problems with making a bush as the column comes complete with enclosed bearings top and bottom. The switchgear is all mounted on the column with wipers, washers and lights included. The column is also tilt adjustable if you require it.

The column fits straight into a Westfield with minimal modification. All you need to do is have the steering shaft splined to fit into the Nissan coupling. You will pay about \$150 for a Nissan column, but it is well worth considering the extra expense. The solution was pioneered by Dave Christy and now Des Edwards has fitted one to his new Westfield.

Make sure you get the flexible coupling and the wiring loom connectors when you buy the column.
